

## CAPSULIZED C.V. OF DR. PATRICK ALAIN AZANZA

**Dr. Patrick Alain T. Azanza is among the country's experts in ICT-based education and ISO-certified learning environment. He graduated from the University of the Philippines under a straight UP Presidential Scholarship Grant for his bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees. He completed *AB Sociology* at UP Los Baños, where he served as **University Student Council Chairman** and the first elected **KASAMA SA UP Chairman** from UPLB. He pursued his *MA Sociology, PhD in Educational Administration, and Juris Doctor (JD)* at UP Diliman.**

Dr. Azanza started his professional career as a **researcher and instructor at UP Diliman**. In 1990, he **joined and was among the original members of the All-UP Workers Union**. He served as **Chief of Staff of UP President Emil Q. Javier**. Eventually, the UP Board of Regents appointed him as the **first HR Director of the entire UP System and concurrent HR Director of UP Diliman**. In 1996, **at the age of 27, he became the youngest recipient of *Lingkod Bayan Award*, the highest award given to outstanding public servants by the President of the Republic, and the Civil Service Commission**. In the same year, he was likewise conferred by the UPLB College of Arts and Sciences Alumni Association, Inc. the *Distinguished UP Alumnus Award for Social Service*. Dr. Azanza continued to serve as **OIC-UPD Vice-Chancellor for Administration; professor and College Secretary at the UP School of Labor and Industrial Relations; and Senior Lecturer at the UP College of Education**. He has authored/co-authored **seven (7) books and has presented/published more than forty (40) academic researches/articles in reputable national and international conferences/fora/publications/journals**.

In the private sector, Dr. Azanza served as **Chief Operations Officer (COO), SVP for Academic Affairs, and Graduate School Dean at the AMA Computer University; President/CEO of Winsource Business Solutions, Inc.; and Environmental Sociologist at the Manila Observatory**. Dr. Azanza's business and management expertise enabled him to serve as **member of various corporate governing Boards** in the banking, power distribution, real estate, construction, agricultural services, environment, education, and IT sectors. He is a consultant at the House of Representatives. **Presently, he is the President/Chief Operations Officer, and member of the Board of Directors of the Eclaro Academy, and the Eclaro Business Solutions, Inc.**, a business process outsourcing and IT firm in the Philippines with headquarters in New York City, USA servicing HP, Canon, IBM, Verizon, CSC, AIG, Arch Insurance, One Beacon, Pfizer, and Merck, among others.

At the international level, Dr. Azanza served as a **Youth Ambassador to ASEAN countries and Japan**. He was a **consultant/team leader for Asian Development Bank (ADB) projects in Central Asia; rural/urban sociology consultant of Rhythm Plus, Uzbekistan; management consultant of the Renardet SA, Geneva Switzerland; marketing partner of the Business Hotel Management Schools-Lucerne, Switzerland; and senior consultant of the French Eiffel-Matiere Consortium**. He was a **member of the board of the British Alumni Association (BAA)**. A multi-awarded author, researcher and academic administrator, Dr. Azanza is also an active community servant. He was an **altar fellow, and member of the Lisieux Music Ministry, as well as the Alleluia Community at the UPLB St. Therese Parish**. He was a **member of the Society of Applied Mathematicians (SAM-UP)**. He served as Executive Director and National Secretary General of the **Junior Chamber International Philippines (JCIP)**, and President of Mandaluyong Jaycees.
